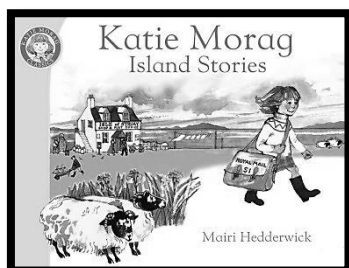
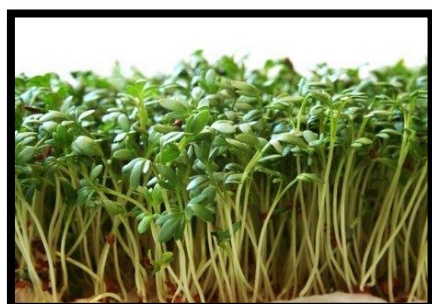


Dear Parent/Carers,



In Literacy, we wrote a letter to the character Katie Morag after reading the stories set on the fictional island of Struay (which is based on the real island of Coll). Making links to our work in Geography, the children wrote about features of Brighouse and asked questions about how the two localities are different.

In Numeracy, we continued to practise speedily recalling times tables facts. We have also been using maps of Struay from the Katie Morag stories to work out distances between different locations. We recapped telling the time using boat crossing timetables between mainland Scotland and the Isle of Struay.



We started our class experiment in Science by planting seeds and placing them under different conditions. We are carefully observing the changes we can see and discussing the reasons for these. Next week during Healthy Living Week, we will be focusing on the human body and the importance of a healthy diet and exercise.
