Dear Parent/Carers,

In Literacy, we have written a book review for 'The Day the Crayons Quit'. Next week, we will be writing a recount about our trip to the mosque.

In Numeracy, we have continued to focus on fractions; finding equivalent fractions, fractions of numbers, amounts and shapes. Next week, we will start a new unit on 'Measures', including work on mass, length, capacity, money and time.

During their Computing lessons, the children have been writing algorithms to control the lights on a bus, using a program called Flowol.

In outdoor PE lessons, we have been working on controlling a ball with our feet, next week we will move onto using a bat and ball.

In RE lessons, we are beginning to explore the Islamic faith and have discussed the similarities and differences to other faiths. We have talked about why some people choose not to belong to a particular faith but that these people still have beliefs and values too. The children were very keen to talk about their own beliefs to do with life and the role of a God or special person.

On Wednesday, 2F thoroughly enjoyed their trip to the mosque and 2H are eagerly awaiting their turn next Wednesday 15th March. Please can we remind you that they will need to bring a cap or scarf to cover their head. They must have their legs and arms covered too.
