In English this week, we have studied poetry. We have been reading poems based on themes such as Summer and have been learning about the structure of poems. The key features we have looked at have been finding thematic words, repetition and rhyming couplets. Next week, we will be writing our own poems focusing on these features and hopefully having some rhyming words.

In Maths this week, we have been practising our fluency with adding and subtracting. We have been discovering strategies to add and subtract in our heads in order to get an answer quicker. We found that if we are adding 11 to a number, we can add 10 first and then add 1. Also, we found if we are adding 9 to a number, we can add 10 first and then subtract 1. We also applied this learning to subtracting 11 and 9 as well and realised it was a quick strategy.

On Tuesday, we were very grateful to have so much support from the Year 2 parents. The children loved making their 'Moving Monster' model with you and they looked fantastic.
