<p><u>Phonics overview</u> The children will be introduced to the first set of sounds following the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds revised programme. They will be taught the sounds in isolation and then taught how to read 2, 3 and 4 letter words by the technique of decoding and blending. Pupils will also be introduced to the first set of 'tricky words' and learn to recognise these instantly by sight.</p> <p><u>Phase 2 graphemes</u> s, a, t, p, i, n, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, l</p> <p><u>Phase 2 tricky words</u> l, is, the</p> <p><u>What we will know</u> Recognise the phase 2 sounds and the tricky words above.</p>	<p><u>Match and sort</u> Pupils will match pictures and objects, They will sort items into sets. Pupils will also sort objects by type and create sorting rules.</p> <p><u>Compare amounts</u> Pupils will compare and order sets. They will use the language 'more' and 'fewer' when comparing sets of objects.</p> <p><u>Compare size, mass & capacity</u> Pupils will begin to compare and order objects by size, using the language 'big', 'little', 'large' and 'small'. They will also use more specific language, such as 'tall' and 'short' when describing height and 'long' and 'short' when comparing length. When learning about mass, the pupils will be introduced to the vocabulary of mass and learn that objects can be compared and ordered by their mass. Pupils will practically compare and order objects by capacity by exploring which 'holds the most' and which 'holds the least'.</p> <p><u>What we will know</u> Match pictures and objects and sort items into sets by type and different sorting rules. Compare and order sets and use mathematical language including more and fewer, taller and shorter.</p>
