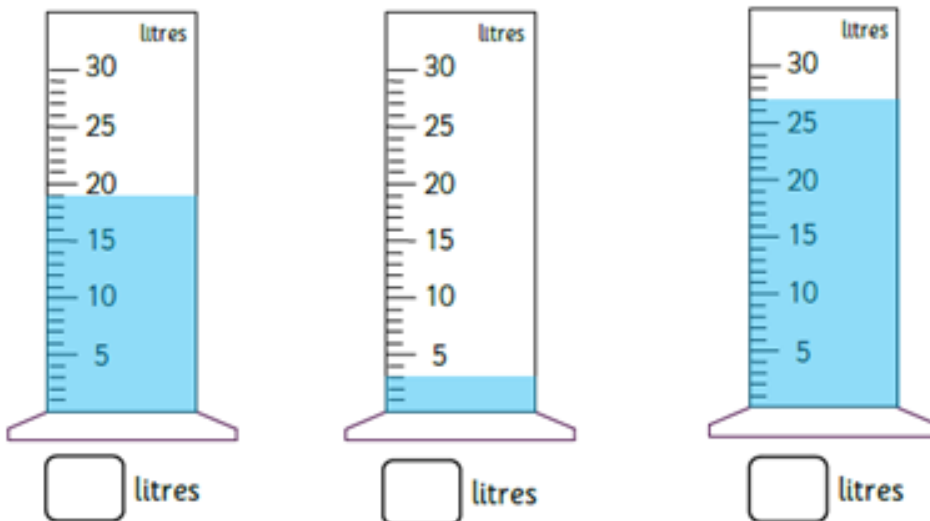


This week's focus: Year 2 Common Exception Words

In English this week, we started our new unit which is recount writing. A recount is a piece of writing or speech that retells past events or experiences in chronological order. Written in the first person ("I" or "we") and past tense, it typically covers personal experiences like trips, school days, or holidays, structured with a clear beginning, middle, and end. Due to having the most amazing time on our school trip to Eureka, we will be writing a recount about this experience.

In Maths, we have looked at capacity and learnt how to measure capacity (by using a jug and reading scales of 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s). We started by measuring different amounts of water. If you have a measuring jug at home, perhaps you could take a few minutes to look at the scale and practise measuring some amounts of different liquids.
