In Phonics, we have continued learning the Phase 5 alternative spelling patterns. This week, we have learnt 'e-e' as in these, 'ew' as in grew, 'ie' as in field and 'aw' as in straw. Our tricky words for the week have been: house, mouse, water and want. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In English, we have enjoyed exploring predictable and patterned language through the story, "Wow!" said the Owl by Tim Hopgood.



This week in Maths, we have been learning about the pairs to 10 and looked at different ways to represent them using ten frames, part whole models and number sentences.

In DT this week, we have made predictions about whether a fruit or vegetable will grow above ground or underground. We looked at where edible parts of plants grow. Next week, we will begin to practise our food preparation skills by cutting and juicing different fruits and vegetables.
