Dear Parents/Carers.

In Literacy this week, we have been focusing on spelling words with the phase 4 cluster sounds fr, bl, fl and gl and then writing captions with some of these spellings in them. We have been remembering a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. We have also had a focus on spelling the phase 3 tricky words. Please keep practising the instant recognition of these words and their spellings. In our handwriting sessions this week we have been practising forming both the 'oo' and 'ar' sounds.



In Numeracy, we have been becoming more familiar with numbers beyond 10 and the pattern of numbers to 20 and beyond. We have been practising describing teen numbers as two parts and used the numicon ten and unifix cubes to build teen numbers practically. The children were asked questions such as 'How will you build the number 10/11/12/13?' 'What number have you built?' 'What do you notice about that number?'




In topic work, we have been keeping a close watch on our tadpoles, waiting patiently for them to turn into froglets. We have been learning about the life cycle of a frog, sharing the story 'The trouble with tadpoles' and finding out further information from our 'Tadpoles and Frogs' information book. We have sequenced the pictures of the life cycle of a frog, thinking about what comes next in the process of changes taking place from a tadpole to a frog.
