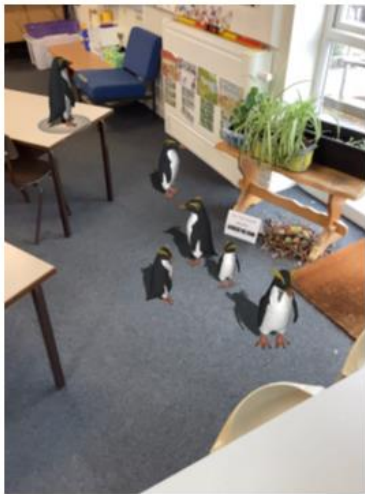

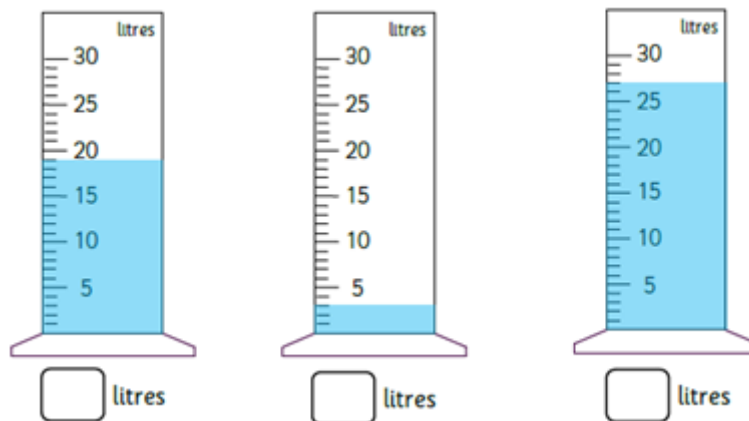
Our spellings for Monday's quiz are:
