In Literacy this week, we have been reviewing all of the phase 3 sounds and focused on words ending in 'ing,' 'ed' and 'est.' We have been recapping all the tricky words learnt so far and learnt the new tricky words out and today.

This week in our handwriting sessions we have been forming the **oi** and **ow** sounds and writing words with these sounds in them.

In Numeracy, we have been learning all about sharing and described equal sharing as fair and unequal sharing as unfair. We worked practically with objects as we shared out equally between different groups. We used key questions such as 'ls it fair?' 'Are the groups equal?' and 'Do all the groups have the same amounts?' You could ask your child to share objects equally at home to find out if they can make their sharing fair.





As part of our Enquiry Learning this week, we have continued our learning of 'Now I am big.' We have been enjoying talking all about when we were babies and created our own baby portraits by making close observations of our baby photographs sent into school.
