During Phonics lessons, our focus sounds have been 'dge' as in fudge, 'ge' village, 'y' as in crystal, 'su' as in usual, and 'si' as in mission. Our tricky words for the week have been: shoe, improve, move, parents, once, eye and friend. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In English, we have started a new book unit on 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartam. We have focused on the chronological vocabulary within the text.

In History, we learnt about Christopher Columbus' discovery of North and South America. The children have been listening to a song on YouTube to help them remember the name of his three ships and the year in which he made his journey across the sea.
