Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have been revising all of the sounds and tricky words that we have learnt. We have been building on our previous learning of reading words ending in 'ing' and 'ed' such as 'painting' and 'crowded' etc. We practised reading the longer words using the chunking method and when we became secure with this, we have been reading these words in one go.

In Numeracy, we have been exploring and talking about 2D and 3D shapes and practised using informal and mathematical language such as 'sides,' 'corners,' 'straight,' 'flat' and 'round.' We have been composing and decomposing shapes as we recognised that shapes can have other shapes within in, just like numbers can. We played 'Guess the shape' as children practised using the language to describe their properties.



As part of our Enquiry Learning this week, we have enjoyed talking and then writing about last week's Reception trip to The Forgotten Forest. We looked at our photographs together then chose our favourite activities to write about them. Well done everyone and we are so pleased you had such a great time. We did too!
