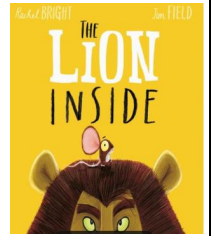


Dear Parent / Carer,

During phonics lessons, we have reviewed words ending in 'ce' (science), 'se' (worse), 'ze' (sneeze), 'le' (apple) and 'al' (metal). We have also recapped the tricky words: move, improve, parents, shoe, thought, whole and who.

In our composition lessons, we have been focusing on the story 'The Lion Inside' and what it teaches us about confidence and courage. The story shows that even a small mouse can feel scared and uncertain, but by being brave and believing in himself, he finds his "lion inside". This helped us think about our own feelings and how we can overcome fears in everyday life.



In DT, we have been learning how to use simple stitches to create decorative bunting through embroidery. We practised threading needles, tying knots, and using running stitches to sew patterns and designs onto the fabric. It required careful concentration and everyone showed determination as they strengthened their skills.

This week, the children really enjoyed sharing their self-studies on animals. They loved presenting the interesting facts they had learned about their chosen animals and made us very proud. It was lovely to see their confidence and excitement as they spoke about their work. Thank you to all parents and carers for your support at home with this project.
