

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have been recapping the 2 and 3 letters sounds and practised finding these sounds within words. We have revised the other tricky words taught so far. We have been practising reading words containing two digraphs such as **sheep** or **march** etc. All pupils will soon be bringing home an information sheet to let you know how well they are doing with phase 2 and 3 sounds. If anyone is unsure of their child's next steps please let us know so we can support you. In our handwriting sessions, we have been practising forming the capital letters L and T.



In Numeracy, we have been exploring objects and introduced the language of length to describe them. We made comparisons between short and long objects and learnt that the 'length' is the distance between two points. You could ask your child to find a collection of short and long objects at home and sort them into two sets to compare.






