If your child is now bringing books home from the school reading scheme system, please remind them to let an adult know in school when their book needs changing. In Year 2, we expect scheme reading books to be changed 2-3 times per week.

In English this week, we have introduced our new unit based on information text. We are reading a text called 'All About Witches' and have started to look at features of an information text. The pupils have created their own witch and decided on its appearance, habitat and behaviour. We are excited to write about these in more detail next week.

In Maths, we have been counting in tens and ones. We have used a 100 square to help us find 1 more and 1 less, as well as 10 more and 10 less. We noticed that when we add or subtract 1, the tens digit does not change, only the ones digit does. When we add or subtract 10, the tens digit changes but the ones digit stays the same. We then had a go at filling in missing numbers on a 100 square using this method.


