



Dear Parent / Carer,

In English, we have started a new unit based on the rhyming book 'Green Eggs and Ham' by Dr Seuss. The children have found this book particularly funny!



This week in Phonics, our sounds have been 'a' as in water, 'a' as in wasp, 'ear' as in pear and 'ere' as in there. Our tricky words for the week have been: who, whole, because, eye, thought and through. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

This week in Maths, we have been sharing amounts and linking this to dividing by 2. Next week, we will begin a new unit on fractions. We will be finding half of objects and amounts.



In PE, we have started our new unit, 'Rugby Fundamentals'. Throughout the unit we will:

- Play a simple game of tag and begin to call 'tag' when taking a bib or belt.
- Practise handing over the rugby ball sideways.
- Attempt to get past a defender 1v1.
- Score a try in a modified drill using correct technique- using 2 hands to place the ball.
- Begin to develop tactics for attacking and defending in a small sided adapted game.

On **Monday 2nd March**, we will begin our new History topic, "How have toys changed?". As part of our topic launch, we would like the children to bring their favourite toy to school on this day.
