This week we are adding the suffix -ed to verbs that end in an e.

The rule is to remove the e and add ed.

Our spellings for Monday's quiz are:

liked	loved	baked	saved
moved	proved	improved	closed

In English this week, we have been creating our own adventure stories. We had to create our main characters, our setting and choose a villain/monster. We have used adjectives to describe the characters and the setting and started to use similes to describe as well. Through drawings and story maps, we have learnt our stories and next week, we will begin to write the openings.

In our Maths lessons this week we have continued to look at crossing the tens boundary when adding.

1. First, we must count the ones and recognise that there are more than 9 ones. We know that we can only have a maximum of 9 in the ones column once we have added the ones together.

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T O} \\ 37 \\ + 25 \\ \hline \hline \end{array}$$

2. Then, once we have added the ones (in this example there are 12), we must exchange ten ones for one ten. We set it out like this:

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{a) T O} \\ 37 \\ + 25 \\ \hline 62 \\ \hline 1 \end{array}$$

a) T O	b) T O	c) T O	d) T O

+ 2 9	+ 1 7	+ 3 5	+ 1 8
