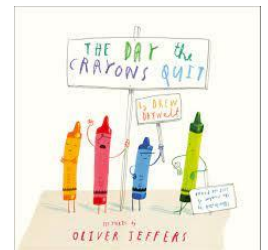

In English this week, we have started a new book called 'The Day the Crayons Quit'. Crayons write letters to their owner explaining their reasons for quitting and this has been entertaining for everyone. We have loved reading this book and understanding the crayons' feelings and reasons for why they want to quit. We have learnt technical vocabulary regarding their emotions and this will help our writing next week when we write back to the crayons.



In Maths, we have focused on telling the time to every 5 minutes as so many children have excelled in this during the past few weeks due to a huge effort, at school and clearly at home. We first looked at telling the time 'past the hour' and counting in 5s and then changed this to 'to the hour' which did cause some confusion at first. However, we linked this to our times tables knowledge and we all started to focus on the minute hand first and then read the hour hand after. Keep up the practice at home everyone!

In Geography, we have been exploring the coastal town of Weymouth, along the Jurassic Coast. We explored the different physical and human features and talked about why people may want to visit the town.



We then had a go at making a radio advert, to encourage people to visit. The children did a great job with this and were able to use their speaking and listening skills effectively.
