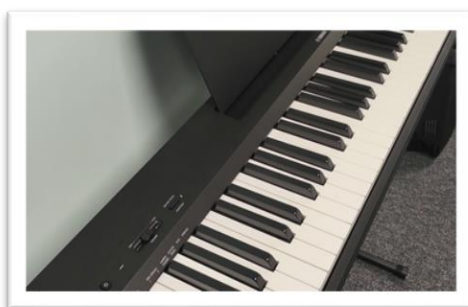
## **Lessons Slots Available At The Old Courthouse**
