



Dear Parent / Carer,

In English, Year 1 have been exploring the story Beegu by Alexis Deacon through lots of rich oral language activities. The children have practised creating sentences using words with the prefix 'un', and they have been forming and asking questions using question marks. Later in the week, we explored adjectives to describe characters and settings from the story. We are really enjoying watching the children grow in confidence as they develop their speaking and storytelling skills.



This week in Maths, we have added equal groups. We have represented adding equal groups in various ways using: concrete apparatus, repeated addition, stem sentences and bar models.

In Art, our focus has been printing with paint. Using Lego, we painted and stamped blocks to create patterns, pictures and letters. We combined primary colours on the page by overlapping prints, to create secondary colours.



This week in Geography, Year 1 have been exploring the school grounds to investigate the current season. The children worked in pairs and followed a simple route around the outdoor areas, using a map to help guide their journey. As they walked, they looked closely at the natural environment and collected seasonal objects such as leaves, twigs and seeds. Back in the classroom, the children used their collections to create their own journey sticks, helping them reflect on the signs of the season they had discovered.
