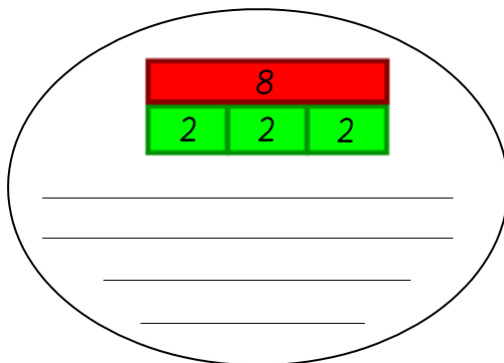


This week's focus: Year 2 Common Exception Words

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In English this week, we have read Traction Man – a story which is on our year group's '50 Book Challenge'. We have read the story and looked for descriptive adjectives for the main character. We wrote a character description as a class and included our amazing adjectives. Then, we decided to create our own superheroes and describe them with creative adjectives.

In Maths this week, we built on our understanding of equal and unequal groups and learnt how to represent multiplication in many different ways by drawing money, Numicon, bead strings, real life examples and bar models. We have also started to explain how we know whether a picture does or does not show a multiplication. We then explored using repeated addition and how it gives us the same answer as a multiplication. For example: 5×3 is the same as $3+3+3+3+3$.



e.g. This bar model does not show 4×2 because there are 3 groups with 2 in each group but there should be 4 groups.

In Art this half term, we have been creating a variety of textures and colours using the primary colours. This week, we have started to create our final collages by using painted backgrounds and cutting and sticking a range of different pictures and materials to them to create shapes. We have loved our collage work and can't wait to share them with you!
