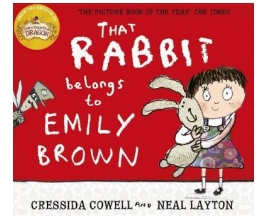


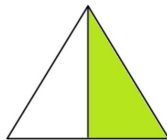
Dear Parent / Carer,

This week in English, we have been exploring the book 'That Rabbit Belongs to Emily Brown'. We have focused on adjectives and applied these within our writing when creating a missing toy poster.

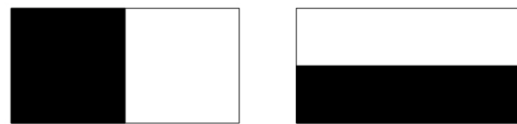


This week in Phonics, our sounds have been 'ch' as in school, 'ch' as in chef and 'ze' as in freeze. Our tricky words for the week have been: laugh, because, eye, our, once and thought. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

In Maths, we have been finding half of shapes. The children were quick to notice two equal parts always make a whole. Using 2D shapes, we discussed how some shapes can only be split in one way (e.g a triangle) whereas others can be halved in multiple ways (e.g a rectangle). Next week, we will finding half of amounts.
