

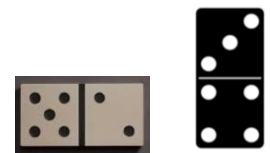
Reception Newsletter

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Literacy this week, we have been recapping the phase 3 sounds and practised blending the sounds together to read words e.g. **rain**, **dark**, **fork**, **hair**, **boxer** and **soil**. We identified the two and three letter sounds in each word and carefully read each word aloud. We have been practising recognising the tricky words **they**, **all**, **are** and **sure**. Please continue to encourage your child to practise recognising these words by sight. Little and often is best.

In Numeracy, we have been exploring the composition of 7. We used dominoes to explore pairs to 7 and recorded number sentences using the + and = signs.



In our topic work, we have enjoyed finding out all about Chinese New Year. We have learnt why some people celebrate Chinese New Year and the different kinds of celebrations that take place. We learnt that this year it is the year of the snake.

Following on from our enquiry learning this week about Chinese New Year, this week's word of the week is: **Festival**

In Reception, we are using the **WellComm language screening tool** to help us support children's early communication and language development. WellComm is a nationally recognised screening programme that looks at areas such as understanding, speaking, vocabulary and listening skills. It helps us identify children who may need a little extra support with their language, as well as those who are developing as expected. Using WellComm allows us to put the right support in place early, helping children build the strong communication skills they need for learning, confidence and social development throughout their time in school. We will be in touch if your child is identified as having a speech and language delay and will work with you to best support you and your child going forward. We have lots of Wellcomm activities that you can use to support your children's language at home so we look forward to sharing those with you.
