Welcome back! We hope you had a restful half term break. We have been impressed with how quickly the children have settled back into school this week and how hard they have worked.



In English this week, we have read Traction Man – a story which is on our year group's '50 Book Challenge'. We have read the story and looked for descriptive adjectives for the main character. We wrote a character description as a class and included our amazing adjectives. Then, we decided to create our own superheroes and describe them with creative adjectives.

In Maths, we have introduced the children to division by sharing. We found out that the groups must be equal just as they are when we multiply. The children have used a bar model to share an amount (see diagram) and were also challenged to use their knowledge
