
Year 1 Newsletter

Dear Parent / Carer,

In Phonics, our sounds this week have been 'a' as in <u>a</u>corn, 'e' as in f<u>e</u>ver, 'i' as in f<u>i</u>nd and 'o' as in b<u>o</u>th. Our tricky words for the week have been: Mr, Mrs, Ms and ask. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

All scheme books and 50 book challenges have been collected today, so they can be checked over the holidays. Next term in Phonics, we will be continuing our teaching of the Phase 5 alternative sounds.

In Maths, we have continued to explore the 'Part Whole Model' to partition (split up) numbers in various ways. We are becoming much more confident in writing four addition facts that can be represented using this model.



After the holidays we will be learning about the pairs to 10 and looking at different ways we can represent them using ten frames, part whole models and number sentences.

In RE, our topic after the holidays will be 'How and why do we care for others?'. To help us talk about the people we care for, we would appreciate it if you could discuss with your child who they care about and send in a photograph.
