
Year 1 Newsletter

Dear Parent / Carer,

In Phonics, our sounds this week have been 'a-e' as in make, 'o-e' as in bone, 'i-e' as in time and 'u-e' as in rude and cube. These graphemes are called split vowel digraphs where one letter goes in between the two vowels. Our tricky words for the week have been: should, could, would, our. These are the words the children need to be able to sight read.

This week in English, we have enjoyed exploring predictable and patterned language through the story, "Wow!" said the Owl by Tim Hopgood. We have started to write own version of the story, thinking of appropriate adjectives to describe the things that the owl saw.



In History, we continued to investigate our personal history using photographs. We discussed changes over time and gained a greater understanding of chronology. We enjoyed making our own memory box and drawing three memories to place in our box.

In DT this week, we have made predictions about whether a fruit or vegetable will grow aboveground or underground. We looked at where edible parts of plants grow. Next week, we will begin to practice our food preparation skills by cutting and juicing different fruits and vegetables.
