

Dear Parents/Carers,


In Literacy this week, we have been practising forming the sounds **ur** and **er**. We have learnt the tricky words **some**, **come**, **love** and **do**. Please keep practising these with your child at home. We have been practising reading some of the phase 4 words such as **chest**, **shelf**, **frog** and **bring**. This week in our handwriting sessions, we have been practising forming the capital letters **C** and **O**.



From the top, curl around to the left to sit on the line.

From the top – all around the O.

In Numeracy we have been continuing our learning about taking away. We used real objects to see that a quantity of a group can be changed by taking away. We used the first, then, now structure as we created our own mathematical stories. We asked the children key questions such as 'How many are there?' 'How many are there now?' 'How many were taken away?'



In topic work, we have enjoyed sharing the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We have been creating wanted posters to help find the giant. We have also been planting our own broad beans, cress and sunflowers and writing instructions for how to plant a seed.

Jack and the Beanstalk song


This week's 'Word of the Week' is: **Enormous.**
